

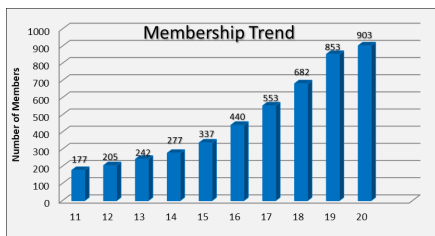

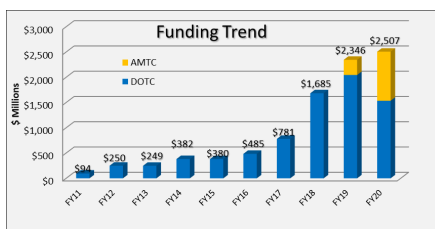
Message from the Executive Director

Dear NAC Members,

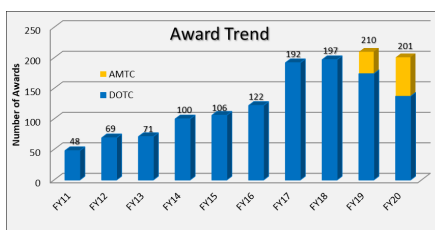
