

Upcoming Deadlines

There are a number of important deadlines quickly approaching. Please don't miss out on the following:

1. The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Acquisition, on behalf of the Office of the Undersecretary of Defense Acquisition and Sustainment (OUSD(A&S)) has issued a Request for Information (RFI) for <u>Weapons Systems or Commercial Capabilities for Ukraine Security Assistance</u>. OUSD(A&S) enables the delivery and sustainment of secure, resilient, and preeminent capabilities to the warfighter and international partners quickly and cost effectively.

Submissions will be reviewed on a rolling basis. Interested companies are encouraged to submit to osd.pentagon.ousd-a-s.mbx.Ukraine-Assistance@mail.mil by 12:00 noon (EDT) on Friday, 6 May 2022. Please reach out to the POC at osd.pentagon.ousd-a-s-mbx.Ukraine-Assistance@mail.mil if you have any questions.

2. On April 27, 2022, the Government published the Request for White Papers (RWP) DOTC-22-07 through the NAC Consortium Management Firm on the Members Only portion of the NAC/DOTC website. The RWP, associated documents, and proposers conference recording are also included on the website. Only NAC Members in good standing can submit a White Paper in response to this solicitation.

Submissions in response to this solicitation will be made via the BIDS online proposal submission system. Additional information on BIDS, including how to register as a new user, is available on the Submitter Quickcard posted on the Members Only site. **The submission deadline is no later than Wednesday, May 18, 2022 3:00 PM Eastern.**

3. The DoD Ordnance Technology Consortium (DOTC) has released Technology Collaboration Plan (TCP) 22-06. The TCP is designed to facilitate the collaboration between Industry and Government prior to the release of future DOTC solicitations. While participation in the TCP process is not a requirement to respond to the solicitation, we strongly encourage NAC members to take advantage of this opportunity to collaborate with the TCP POCs.

Members should visit the <u>NAC Members Only site</u> and click on <u>TCP-22-06</u> under "**Document Library**" to view the TCP-22-06 document. Technology Collaboration Topics assigned to TCP-22-06 are also viewable in BIDS. DOTC requests members **submit 1-3 pages (plus cover page) via <u>BIDS</u> in response to TCP-22-06, and must submit NLT 3:00 pm EST 23 May 2022.**
